# INTRODUCTION

In May 2012, Chicago Public Schools (CPS) launched a process to develop the first district-wide [CPS Arts Education Plan](#), led by the Department of Arts Education with support from Ingenuity and the Department of Cultural Affairs and Special Events (DCASE). Rooted in the city's [Cultural Plan of 2012](#), this initiative resulted in recommendations that shaped the CPS Arts Education Plan, approved by the CPS Board of Education in the fall of 2012.

A key element of the 2012 CPS Arts Education Plan was the call for an external funding stream and a coordinated public-private strategy to drive investments in school-level arts partnerships, equitable funding, and resources for sustainable arts programming. In response, the Creative Schools Fund (CSF) was established in 2013 by Ingenuity, with funding from private and philanthropic donors.

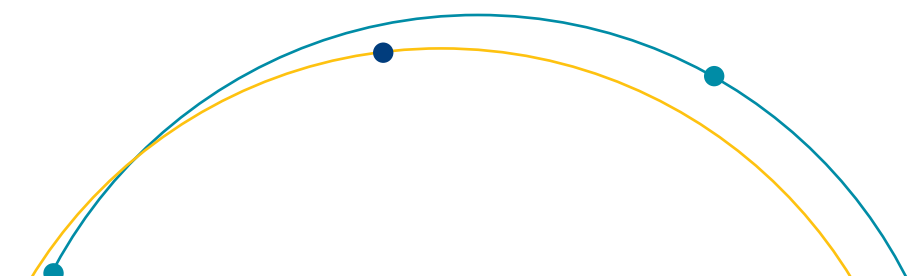
Since its creation in 2013, the Creative Schools Fund has played a pivotal role as the most impactful lever for school change in the arts, driving systemic transformation and ensuring accountability for every dollar invested.

The Creative Schools Fund is unique as the only fund of its kind, ensuring that funding directly impacts students by supporting teacher-led arts programs and tracking where and how dollars are spent.

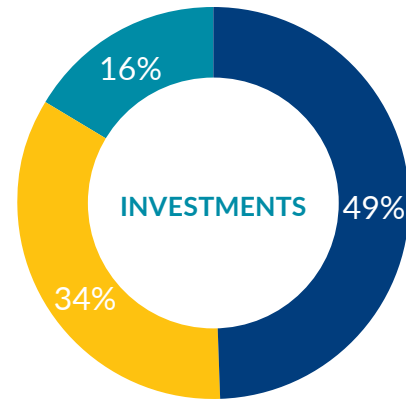
As CPS embarks on the development of a new [Arts Education Plan](#), the Creative Schools Fund once again will be called upon to help operationalize and fund programs that ensure all students – regardless of their background or neighborhood – benefit from the opportunities the new plan will create.

With over \$21 million invested in schools since 2013, the Creative Schools Fund stands as the largest philanthropic investment in CPS arts education. This report dives into the transformative impact of CSF over the past decade, showcasing its success in expanding equitable access to the arts and its enduring contributions to Chicago's students, teachers, and schools.

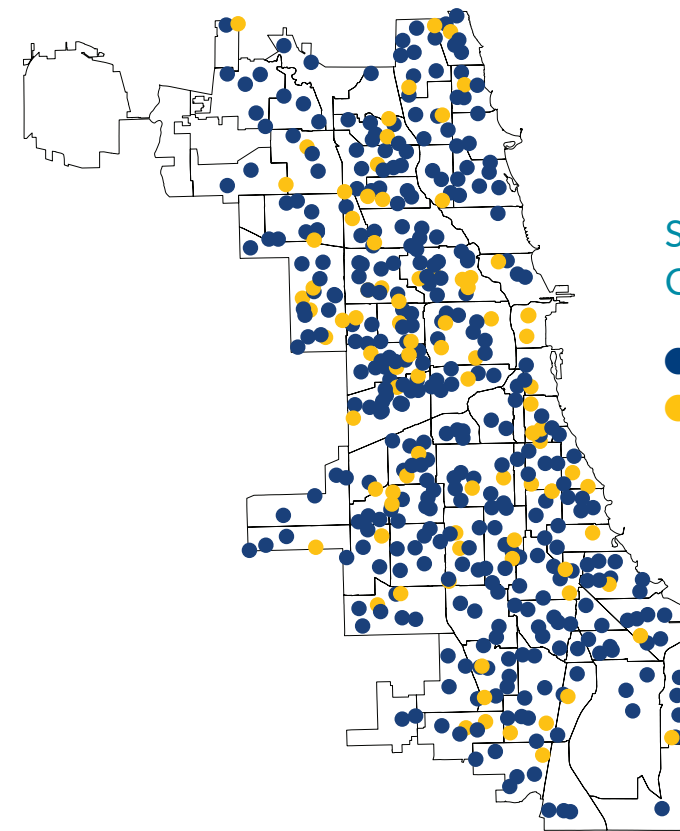

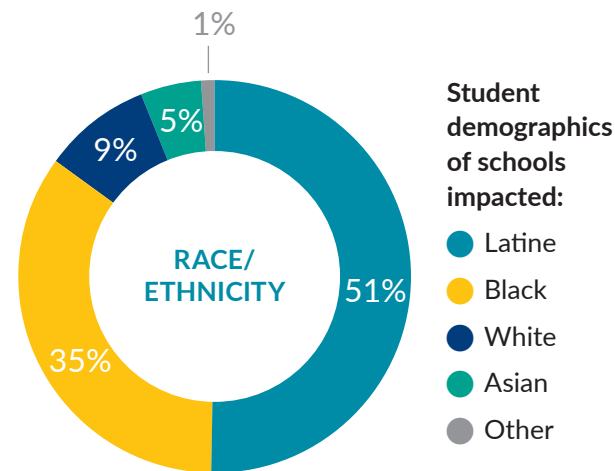

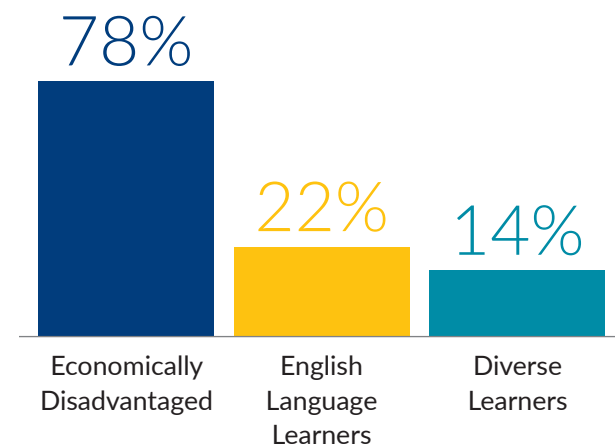

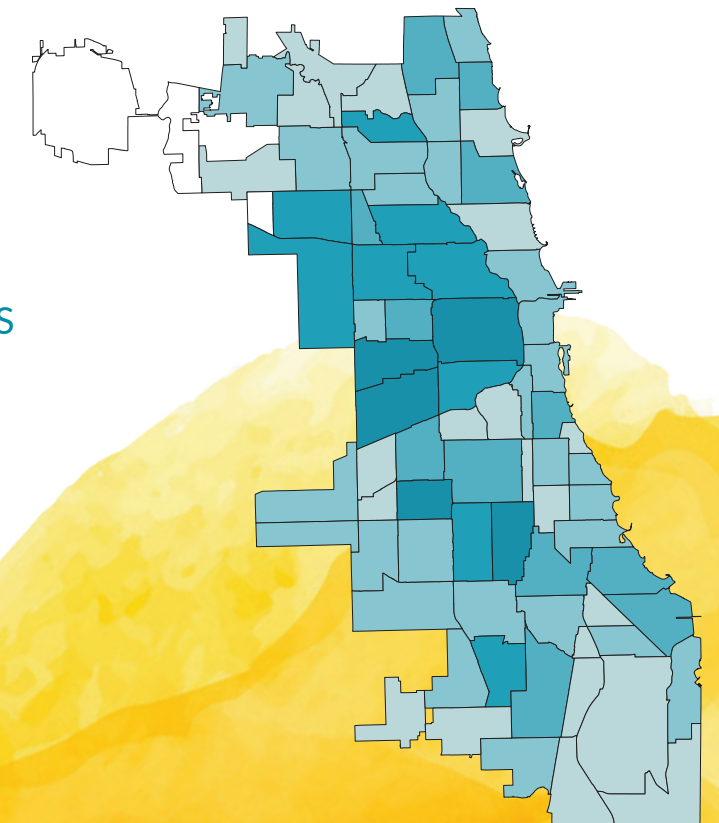

# INVESTMENT HISTORY & PROCESS



## HOW FUNDS ARE DISTRIBUTED

The Fund is a public-private partnership between Ingenuity, CPS, and the city. All funds are distributed to CPS to disburse to individual schools through grant programs designed and administered by Ingenuity. Ingenuity raises private funds to disburse to CPS. City funds go directly to CPS to disburse to schools.



# CREATIVE SCHOOLS FUND INVESTMENT HISTORY

**INGENUITY BEGINS RAISING \$16 MILLION IN PRIVATE FUNDING** – with backing from City Hall, the Chicago Board of Education, and civic leaders.

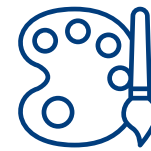

# CREATIVE SCHOOLS FUND INVESTMENT TYPES

The Fund's impact is multifaceted, prioritizing schools with the least systemic arts access, delivering immediate arts programs to students, and fueling sustainable, long-term increases to arts education. Over the years, there have been many support mechanisms under the umbrella of the Creative Schools Fund: Arts Essentials Grants, Summit Vouchers, and Competitive and Data-informed Grants.

## ARTS ESSENTIALS GRANTS

**Arts Essentials** Grants provide funding for schools to purchase consumable arts resources like papers, paint, and clay, and non-consumable resources such as cameras, costumes, and instruments. These funds are available to all CPS schools that submit their annual arts education programming data. Since the 2016–17 school year, over 90% of CPS schools have submitted their arts education data annually. In recent years, Arts Essentials Grants provide \$1,000 per school.

## SUMMIT VOUCHERS

Vouchers are provided at various Ingenuity Summit events throughout the year as part of the Creative Schools Fund's commitment to seeding and igniting arts partnerships. These vouchers financially support collaborations between schools and Chicago's arts partner community based on matching school needs to partner assets through data from [artlook](#).<sup>®</sup> The funds from Summit Vouchers can be used in a variety of ways, including supporting short-term residencies, workshops, professional development, and consulting and planning services. Eligibility for these vouchers is based on attendance at Ingenuity Summit events, and winners are randomly selected through a drawing. In recent years, Summit Vouchers funding amounts range from \$1,000 to \$2,500.

## COMPETITIVE AND DATA-INFORMED GRANTS

A primary goal of the Fund is to accelerate and deepen arts access by incentivizing arts-positive behaviors in schools and supporting specific strategies tied to [Creative Schools Certification](#) school-level arts education indicators.

Competitive and Data-informed grantees represent every CPS network, nearly every Chicago neighborhood, and schools of every type. Supported by public and private funding sources from Ingenuity, CPS, and the City of Chicago, this public-private partnership and significant financial commitment underscore the broader recognition of the arts as an essential component of a holistic education — one that fosters creativity, critical thinking, and emotional intelligence in students.

### COMPETITIVE GRANTS

A majority of the Creative Schools Fund has been allocated through Competitive Grants, which have evolved over the years to address the changing needs of arts education in CPS. These grants are designed with tailored priorities, with different grant streams.

Competitive Grant projects bring immediate arts programs to students — and fuel sustainable, long-term increases to arts education access for every student, in every grade. Grants support student programming during the school day.

The largest share of these Competitive Grants is dedicated to supporting arts partnerships between schools and community arts organizations, highlighting the value placed on these collaborations as essential for enriching the student daily experience. Importantly, CSF supports

schools, not arts organizations — even if a majority of partnership dollars are ultimately allocated to partners through vendor contracts.

Starting in the 2022–23 school year, the introduction of multi-semester grants has further amplified this impact, providing extended funding that enables schools and arts organizations to cultivate enduring arts programs and forge robust and sustainable longer-term partnerships.

Competitive Grants are administered through an open, transparent process. Decisions are guided by a review committee of arts practitioners, educators, teachers and teaching artists, and practicing artists. Since its inception, the Fund has embraced participatory grantmaking, a collaborative approach that empowers community members to play an active role in deciding how grant funds are allocated. Members reflect the demographics of Chicago's public schools, every arts discipline, and a cross-section of roles within the arts education sector — ensuring grant decisions are objective and fair.

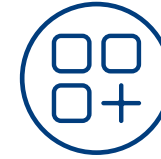
Grant reviewers recommend grant approvals to the Ingenuity Board of Directors, which assumes full responsibility for fulfillment of granting commitments to schools, allocation of funds in keeping with donor intent, and Fund continuity through ongoing fundraising and visibility efforts.

### DATA-INFORMED GRANTS

In addition to supporting arts partnerships, other grant supports have been developed to address a range of data-informed priorities. These include leadership awards that enable schools to engage in peer-to-peer learning, curriculum development initiatives, support for physical improvements to arts spaces, and scheduling consultancies.

## OTHER INITIATIVES

While Arts Essentials, Summit Vouchers, and Competitive and Data-Informed Grants have been core components of the Creative Schools Fund since its inception in 2013, additional funds have been allocated for other targeted initiatives. In the 2014–15 school year, several initiatives were introduced, including the Creative Compass, Arts Content Framework, and Arts Professional Learning Cycles.

The Creative Compass program, developed by the CPS Department of Arts Education in collaboration with Ingenuity, provided school leaders with a set of materials and peer-to-peer coaching designed to enhance their schools through the arts. These resources were carefully aligned with the goals and priorities outlined in the [2012 CPS Arts Education Plan](#). The Arts Content Framework was a curricular tool that mapped learning to established arts standards, providing a shared foundation for quality instruction and arts practices across schools. Additionally, the Arts Professional Learning Cycle was introduced to establish relevant, ongoing professional development for CPS arts educators. This initiative was designed to align with district goals while also building the capacity of arts educators, empowering educators to continuously improve their practice.



# COMPETITIVE AND DATA-INFORMED GRANTS

## CREATIVE SCHOOLS CERTIFICATION

Data from the [Creative Schools Certification](#) is used in determining eligibility and to guide portfolio decision-making for Creative Schools Fund Competitive and Data-informed Grants. The Creative Schools Certification, or CSC, is the result of a collaboration between Ingenuity and the CPS Department of Arts Education, and is a non-punitive school-level arts indicator that provides principals, teachers, and families with a comprehensive overview of the arts offerings in their school and a roadmap for expanding access and quality.

The Creative Schools Certification uses a points-based scoring scale in which every school can receive up to 100 points and is then rated on a four-level scale of Excelling, Strong, Developing, and Emerging. The ratings from the CSC are as follows:

**EXCELLING (90-100 POINTS):** Schools that meet the goals and priorities outlined in the [2012 CPS Arts Education Plan](#)

**STRONG (80-89 POINTS):** Schools that nearly meet the goals and priorities outlined

**DEVELOPING (70-79 POINTS):** Schools that occasionally meet the goals and priorities outlined

**EMERGING (FEWER THAN 70 POINTS):** Schools that rarely meet the goals and priorities outlined

**INCOMPLETE DATA:** Schools that submitted partial or no data

## HISTORY OF COMPETITIVE AND DATA-INFORMED GRANTS

The following outlines grant streams administered for each year since the Fund's inception in the 2013-14 school year. Creative Schools Fund Competitive and Data-informed Grants continually adapt to meet the evolving needs of the school district and arts education sector.

Notably, the Lollapalooza Arts Education Fund (LAEF) was established through a generous \$2.2 million investment over five years via the Creative Schools Fund starting in the 2021-22 school year, and continues to make a significant difference in Chicago Public Schools. The Lollapalooza Arts Education Fund supports grants for CPS schools to enhance the quality of and access to arts education, particularly in under-resourced schools. LAEF prioritizes schools with the least systemic arts access, which are predominantly located on the South and West sides of the city. Through arts residencies, field trips, professional learning for teachers, and improvements to arts spaces, the Lollapalooza Arts Education Fund brings the city's rich arts and cultural resources into its public schools.

## CSF COMPETITIVE AND DATA-INFORMED GRANTS STATISTICS

Over 1,300 Competitive and Data-informed Grants have been awarded to schools since the 2013-14 school year.

Multi-semester Partnerships Grants were introduced in 2022-23, and these grants provided funding over multiple semesters up until 2025-26 for a given partnership between a school and an arts organization. These grants foster deeper student impact and greater sustainability by allowing schools and their arts partners to engage in long-term, meaningful collaborations. This approach marks a new strategy within the Creative Schools Fund, prioritizing deeper impact within individual schools and with the same student body, rather than broadening reach. Unlike historical approaches, which focused on expanding the number of schools and students served, this new approach focuses on sustained, in-depth engagement.

<sup>4</sup>Since the Creative Schools Fund influences school-wide investments in the arts, the number of students impacted indicates the total student population of schools that were awarded grants in a given school year.

<sup>5</sup>Schools could apply for Residencies & Student Learning Experiences Grants during both the fall and winter cycles. Additionally, schools could receive multiple grants across various streams available that year, including Residencies & Student Learning Experiences, Dedicated Arts Spaces, Minutes of Instruction, and Disciplines & Depth.

The creation of a new [CPS Arts Education Plan](#) will address these challenges by ensuring that arts education remains central to student achievement and overall well-being. Ingenuity's Creative Schools Fund will once again be called upon to play a vital role, leveraging its infrastructure to support the new strategic initiatives. The Fund is uniquely positioned to help operationalize and fund programs that guarantee every student — regardless of their background or neighborhood— benefits from the opportunities the new plan will create.

Building on a decade of success, the Fund remains committed to its mission of providing every student in every grade with access to comprehensive, enriching arts experiences that foster academic success and personal growth for years to come.
